## Abington Rep. launches new Real Diehl Report

The first Real Diehl Report focused on transportation, more specifically the MBTA. A 2014 internal audit showed that the T doesn't perform adequate inventorying of its fleet, doesn't comply with federal transit authority guidelines and doesn't properly verify use of vehicles by T staff.

The second Real Diehl Report focuses on self-auditing of transportation.

Announcer: This is the Real Diehl Report with state Rep. Geoff Diehl who chaired the repeal of automatic gas tax hikes.

Diehl: I'm Geoff Diehl. As a family man, I know the heavy burden of taxes. That's why I've been fighting for accountability of our tax dollars on Beacon Hill. Several years ago in a cost saving measure the Department of Transportation was merged with the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority. Buried in the bill having the new Department of Transportation self audit. That's right; people within the agency review the agency. It is not the transparency we want or expect from our state government. Quite frankly, it's no wonder why it costs taxpayers \$675,000 per mile in road maintenance every year. The Commonwealth is the second highest in the nation. It is time for better management and better fiscal oversight, not more tax dollars.
